Camp Details and Instructions

Children / Young People

- Parents must be responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.
- The camp is located on a lake. No lifeguard is present. Anyone swimming under 16 must have a parent at the lake.
- Anyone under 18 without a parent at camp should have a signed medical consent form.

Clothing

- Swimsuits must be decent (no bikinis); please wear cover ups to/from beach area.
- Modest clothing please.
- Shirts to be worn unless swimming.
